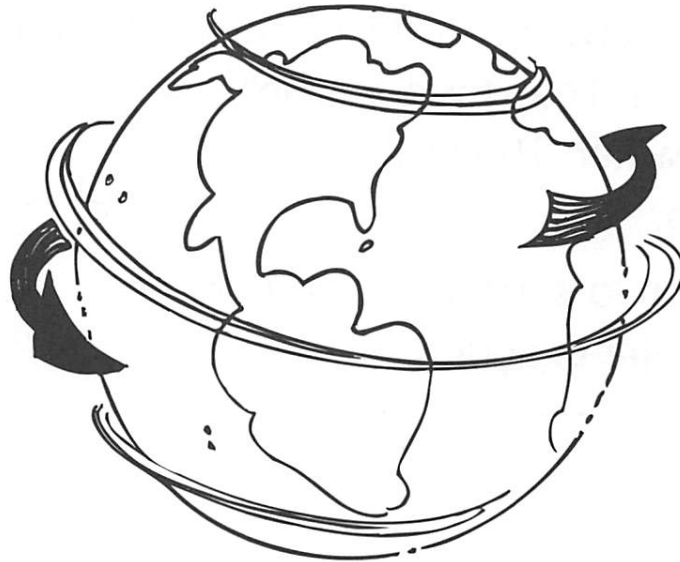


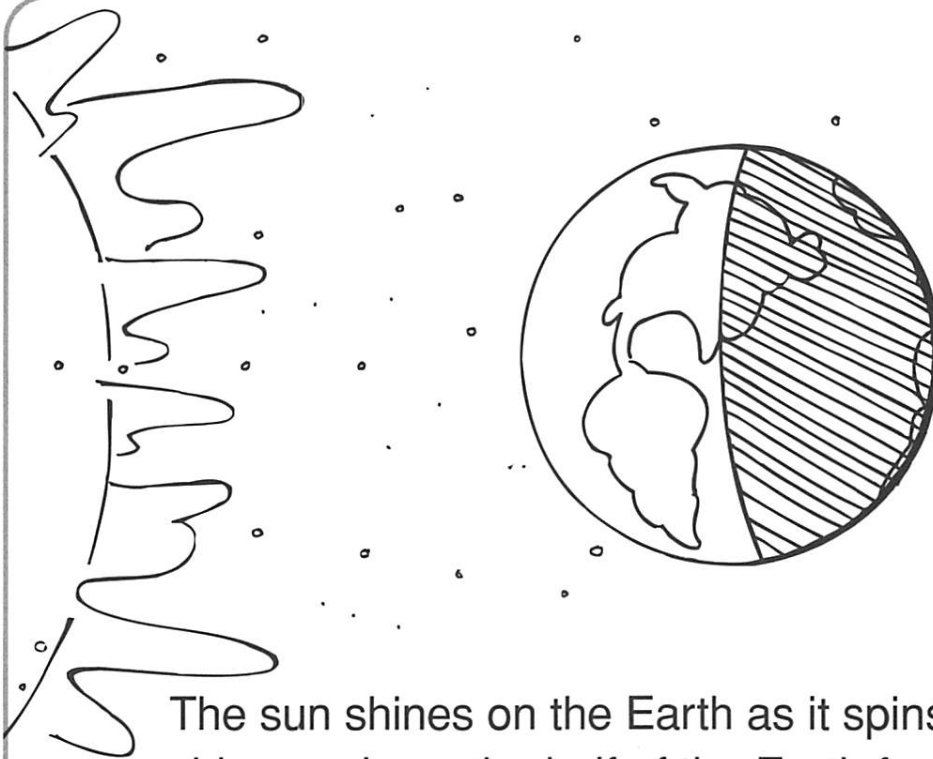
Day and Night

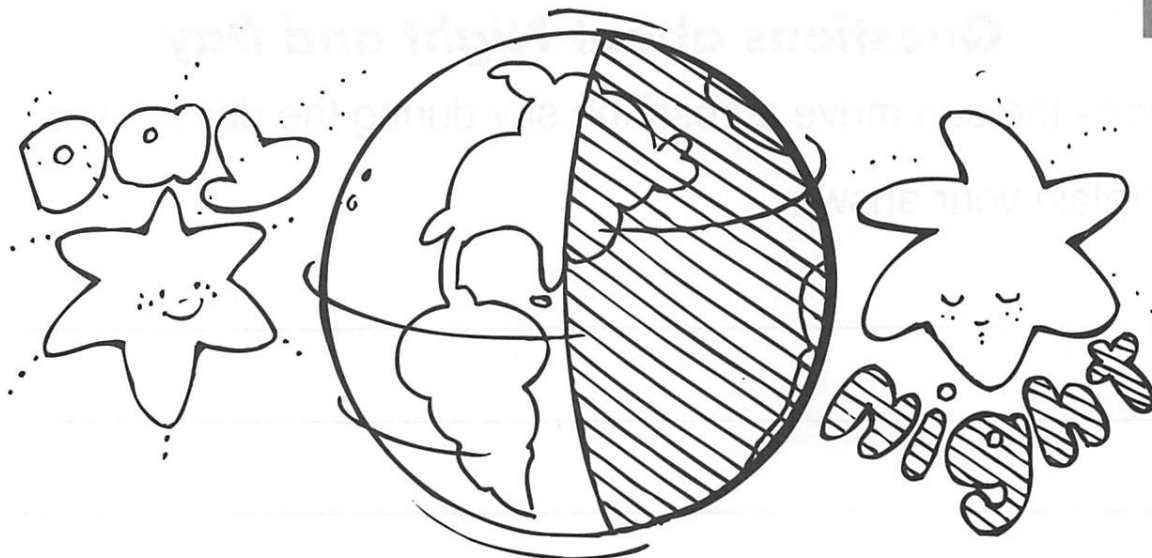


The Earth turns around and around. It never stops.
It makes one whole turn every 24 hours.

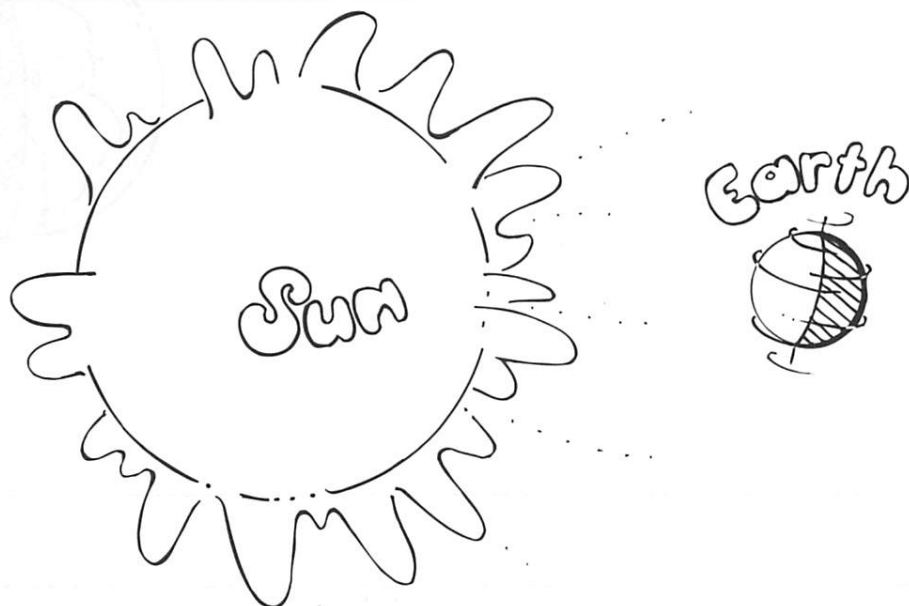

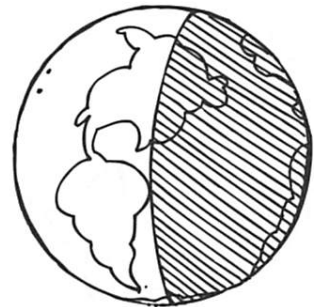
