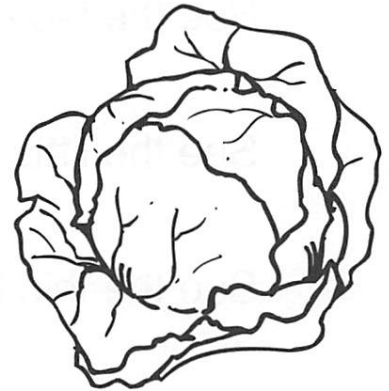
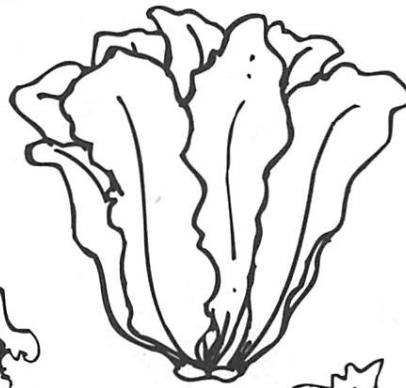
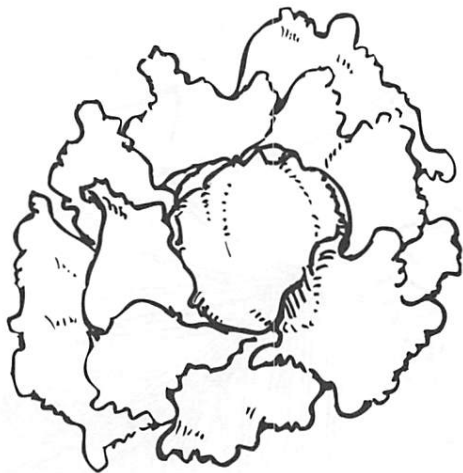


Leaves help plants grow.

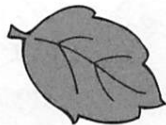

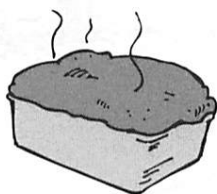
