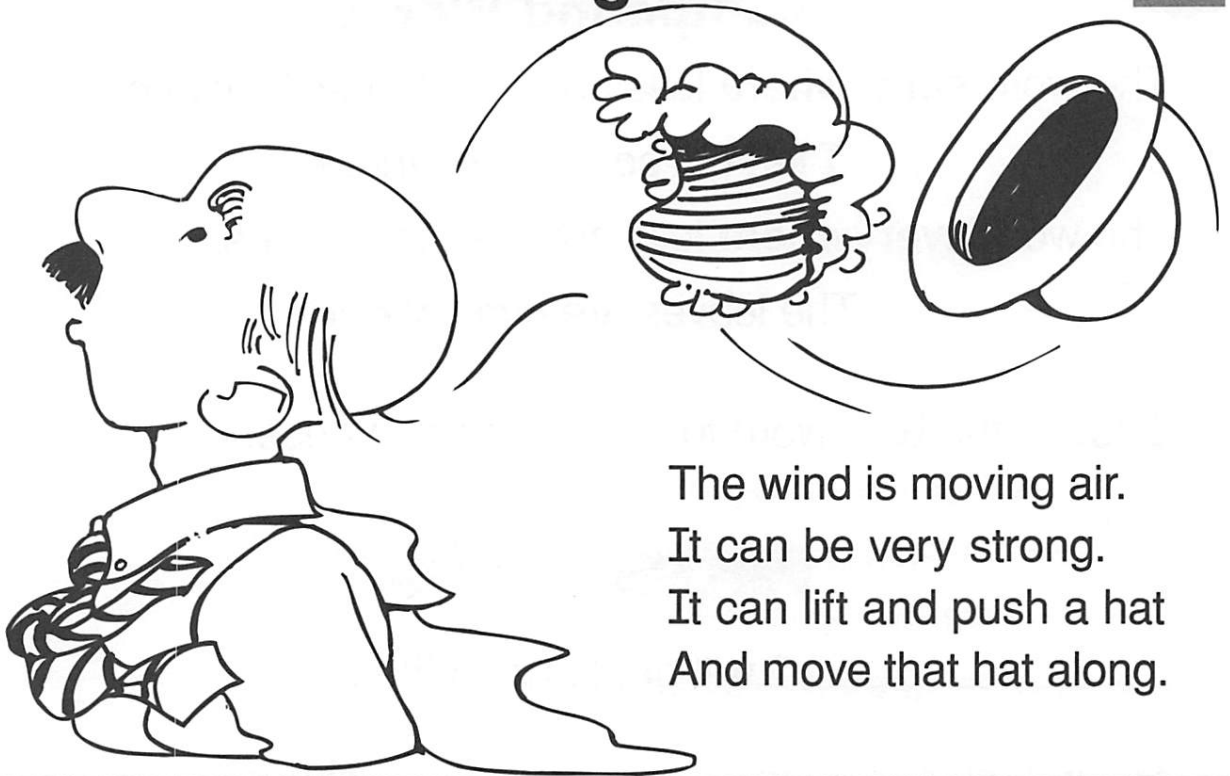


# Moving Air

And move that hat along.

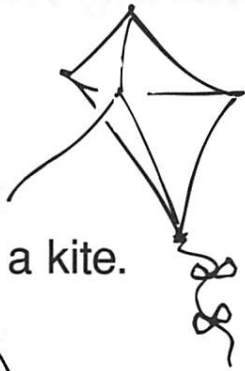
I can make the air move.

Moving air makes energy—

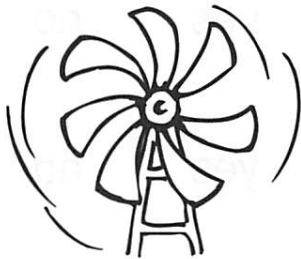

It can pump some water.



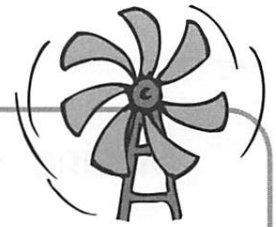
It can move a sailing boat.

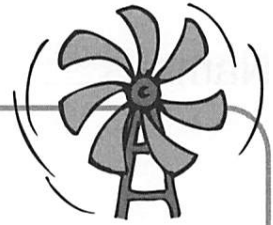

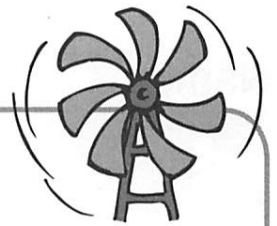
